23rd June, 2008 - Lease Corporation International (LCI) has today announced the order of six new Airbus A330-300 aircraft powered by Rolls-Royce Trent 700 engines. All six aircraft will be delivered in 2009 and 2010 and will be placed on operating leases with Singapore Airlines.

These aircraft join a Boeing 747-400F already leased to Singapore Airlines Cargo through LCI's associated Singapore affiliate, Singapore Commercial Leasing.
